Religious Education 2023-2024

Dear Families,

We're so happy that you are enrolling your child(ren) in Religious Education classes. Now more than ever, we need to prioritize that our kids have a strong faith foundation!

This year Father Chris, our Pastor at St Mary Catholic Church and myself, the Director of Religious Education want our program to focus on the spiritual growth of the children, as well as their knowledge of our beautiful Catholic faith and the doctrine of the Church, which in turn will create faithful Catholics for a lifetime, and not just a family looking for a Sacrament for their child in order to check the box. To accomplish this purpose, our Pastor has made Mass Attendance and Parent Classes mandatory for families who have children preparing for First Communion and youth preparing for Confirmation. The youth will also have to do Service Hours (20) at the Church (VBS, Choir, Service Day, Fish Fry, etc.) These requirements will be recorded weekly and presented to Father Chris; if a family is not fulfilling these requirements, Father Chris will meet with them to discuss further. Before the date of the Sacrament, Father Chris will meet with each family and will test the child to determine if he or she is prepared to receive their Sacrament.

Please, register *early* to help us prepare and order materials accordingly.

The Registration fees are as follows:

- 2. Please fill out the R.E. Registration form. Make sure that all information is current and that your phone numbers, mailing, and email addresses are correct. PLEASE WRITE LEGIBLY.

3. New students:

- a) Fill out the Student Pick-up Permission and Emergency Notification and Release of Liability form (one form per child).
- b) Include copies of OFFICIAL birth and sacramental certificates.
